

Minnesota Angus Association State Sale Grant Program

Purposes of the Grant Program:

- 1. To provide quality Angus Females to youth interested in starting an Angus herd.
- 2. To encourage youth to show & promote Angus, to become involved in the Angus Junior program.

Youth Eligible for these grants must meet the following criteria

- 1. Must be 9 years old as of January 1 of the current year and may not have passed their 21st birthday prior to January 1.
- 2. The Grant is for the purchase of an Angus heifer or bred heifer at the Best of Breeds MINNESOTA ANGUS ASSOCIATION STATE SALE held in Hutchinson, Minnesota third weekend in December.
- 3. Recipient of Grant must be present at the sale in Hutchinson, MN to receive and use the Grant.
- 4. Must be able to provide an amount at least equal to or greater than the amount of the Grant to purchase an Angus female.
- 5. Purchased female must be transferred into the name of the Grant recipient.

Expectations of the Association regarding Grant Recipients

- 1. Grant recipients are strongly encouraged to exhibit their purchase the Minnesota Junior Angus Association Field Day Show held in June
- 2. Grant recipients are asked to give a report on their purchase at the Jr Field Day show, or the Junior meeting at the next Beef Showcase.
- 3. Recipient agrees to abide by rules of the Minnesota Junior Angus Association, National Junior Angus Association and the IAFE (International Association of Fairs and Expositions) Code of Show Ring Ethics. Copies of these rules are available from Association Executive Secretary, contact information listed below.
- 4. Properly care for the female purchased
- 5. Non-compliance with these requests by recipients may affect future chances to receive a Grant

All grants will be \$500

- 1. Grants are not transferable and do NOT carry over to the next year
- 2. Grants are not limited to a one-time issuance; recipient may apply for a Grant in following years after receiving a Grant
- 3. Grants are applied to the purchase price of an Angus heifer or bred heifer.

 (Example: \$2000 cost of the female minus \$500 Grant = \$1500 cost to recipient for the purchase of the female)
 - (Example: \$2500 cost of the female minus \$500 dant = \$1500 cost to recipient for the
- 4. Grant will include a 1 year membership to the Minnesota Junior Angus Association

Grants are awarded on the following basis

- 1. A Selection Committee comprised of at least three non-biased individuals will score the applications
- 2. No names will appear on the application portion submitted to the selection committee
- 3. Application must be completed by the applicant
- 4. Criteria for scoring of grants
 - a. Ability to care for animal
 - b. Sense of responsibility
 - c. Integrity
 - d. Good candidate for continuing with Angus
 - e. Completeness of the application
- 5. If the applicant has received a Grant previously, adherence to the rules and request, such as showing at the field day show and giving a report will be considered when scoring current application
